5 ROOTS OF FAITH/ USUL AD DIN (Shi'a Islam)	
1. God is one (Tawhid)	There is one God who made the universe and all life. To worship other gods is a mistake.
2. God is just (Adalat)	God is just and the world God created is just. God does not make mistakes like humans. From 'adl' meaning 'just' in Arabic.
3. God sends the message of Islam to prophets (al- Nubuwah)	God gives information to prophets to help humans stay on the right path. From the Arabic 'Nabi' meaning 'prophet'
4. God sends the message of Islam to Imams (al- Imamah)	God also sends leaders to guide people. The Imams are singular leaders chosen by God. Imamah means 'leadership'.
5. There will be a day of resurrection (al- Mad'ad, or Yawm al-Qiyamah)	Although God cannot cause injustice, humans are prone to mistakes. The justice of God is seen in the final balance of resurrection and judgment, and in the afterlife.
