


How might pupils use the My FutuRE My CaREer My RE resources at home?



Although these resources are aimed at Key Stage Three and above, they may still be useful for Key Stage 2 pupils.

Activities pupils could do at home include:

A: Choose one of the featured former RE pupils.

- Read their story and watch their video
 - Answer these questions
 - What's their name?
 - What job do they have?
 - How did studying RE help them in this job?
- B. Choose three of the featured former RE pupils.
 - Read their stories and watch their videos
 - Design a poster that shows what they say are the important things that RE taught them that they can use in their careers
- C. Choose one of the featured former RE pupils.
 - Read their story and watch their video
 - Create a set of questions that you would like to ask them
 - Send your questions to another pupil or upload to a shared virtual learning space.

- Ask other pupils to suggest answers to your questions.
- D. Choose up to three of the featured former RE pupils.
 - Read their stories and watch their videos.
 - Now consider another career that is not featured on the website. It might be a career you are interested in pursuing yourself.
 - Write a short story as if you are a person in this career saying how your RE learning has been important.
