



REFLEXIVITY

EPISTEMIC & PERSONAL AWARENESS

CATEGORISATION



- Worldviews as fluid, dynamic and interpretable
- Questioning what counts
- Getting rid of boxes
- Deconstruction of traditional ways of knowing
- Epistemic awareness
- Contributes to decolonisation of curriculum

REFLEXIVITY



- Increasingly a key feature of RE across Europe
- Worldviews approach rooted in philosophical hermeneutics
- Metacognition essential to 'selfcritical scholarship'
- Foregrounds importance of subjectivity

ENCOUNTER



- Emphasises dialectical nature of understanding.
- Beyond critical thinking to critical self-reflection and critical action.
- Critical, transformational pedagogy
