A survey (2023) was completed with 2 secondary North West England schools, one Catholic and one without a religious character to explore the parental viewpoint on Religious Education and religion and worldviews. Over 300 parents responded to this survey.

90% of parents believe it is important for young people to understand the beliefs of others

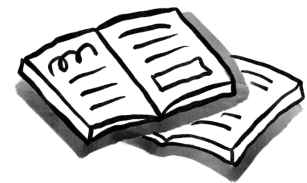


76% of parents believe Religious Education helps young people to understand each other



69% of parents have spoken to their children about how the world was created and what could happen after we die

65% of parents believe Religious Education is an important part of the school curriculum



71% of parents believe Religious Education helps young people gain a better understanding of their own beliefs
